Get Cookin!



Thick Hot Chocolate served with Doughnut Sticks

Ingredients:

- 200g bar of good dark chocolate
- 150 ml cream or milk
- 1 cup white cake flour
- 1/4 tsp baking powder
- 1 cup water
- 1 TBS oil
- Pinch salt
- 1 tsp sugar
- Oil for frying
- Sugar to sprinkle over fritters when still hot

Directions:

- 1 • Gently melt 200g dark chocolate with 150ml cream or milk. I like to add a little chilli powder to give the chocolate a kick.
- 2 • Heat the oil in a heavy bottomed pot for frying the fritters. The oil needs to be deep enough to allow the fritters to float freely when frying. Sift the cake flour and baking powder into a bowl. Bring the water, salt, sugar and 1TBS oil in a medium sized pot to the boil. Add the boiling water to the dry flour, whisking constantly until the mixture is a smooth dough without lumps. The dough should be sticky and not runny.
- 3 • Spoon the dough into a piping bag and carefully squeeze the dough into hot oil. I prefer to cut the dough as I am busy squeezing it into the oil with a knife or scissors - this does however take a little practice, so we make several smaller fritters. Fry until golden. Remove with a slotted spoon and drain on paper towel.
- 4 • Serving Suggestion: If you have made one long fritter it can be cut into manageable lengths with a knife. Dredge with the sugar or sugar mixed with cinnamon. Serve warm.
