Ingredients for pudding:

- 1 egg 1 cup sugar
- 1 T apricot jam
- 1 cup flour pinch salt
- 1 t bicarb
- 1 T butter (melted)
- 1 cup milk
- 1 t vinegar (add to melted butter)

Directions for pudding:

Beat egg & sugar, add jam, Sift flour, salt & bicarb. Alternate adding dry & wet ingreds to egg. Grease dish, pour in, cover with foil. Bake @ 180C for 45-50 mins.

Ingredients for the sauce:

- 100ml cream
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup cold water
- 4 T butter
- 1 tsp vanilla essence

Melt together & pour over hot pudding.
